

4. A **registration fee of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00)** shall be charged to each participant to defray expenses for (4) snacks, (2) lunch meal, activity materials, certificates, venue and other operating expenses.

5. The registration fee and travel expenses are chargeable against the School MOOE, local funds, scouting funds, Municipal SEF funds, PTA Funds or solicited from private organizations subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

6. Things to bring: Participants are advised to bring the following: Type A Scout Uniform (Long Pants); Smart Casual Clothes for Socials, Laptop, Tents & Beddings, Food (Breakfast & Dinner).

All Adult Leaders who will attend the said activity will be given service credits/ Compensatory Time Off (CTO) which fall on Saturday and Sunday on condition that their names will appear on the official attendance form of the event and each of them must submit a daily time record (DTR) with the approved Travel Order duly signed by the School Head/ Principal, District Supervisor/ DepEd Schools Division Superintendent prior to its submission to the Division Office.

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
