SY 2025- 2026**



1. In reference to Department of Education Advisory from the office of the Director Bureau of Learner Support and Services dated January 21, 2026 on the National Uploading and Validation of Wash In School (WiNS) Program all public elementary and secondary schools in this Division are hereby directed to strictly comply the submission of WiNS data report.
2. The National Uploading and Validation of Wash In School Program will commence on January 26, 2026 and will continue until March 31, 2026 using the LIS or Enhance Monitoring System (E- OMS).
3. To ensure the 100 % compliance, all school heads are strictly directed to complete the upload of their report two weeks prior **to the National closing of the e-Wins OMS**. This is to prevent access and uploading issues caused by surge submission near the deadline which may result in the unsuccessful submission of reports.
4. All Public Schools District Supervisors are directed 100 % submission of all the schools under their charge.
5. The school may contact Mr. Felimon Rey Corpin, Division ITO and Mark Andrew Bentor Nurse II, for queries regrading Enhance Online Monitoring System.
6. Attached herewith is DepEd BLSS Advisory for reference.

The uploading will commence on **January 26, 2026** and continue until **March 31, 2026** in reference to DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2016 or the "Policy and Guidelines for the Comprehensive Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene in (WASH) in Schools (WinS) Program which established quality standards for water, sanitation, deworming and health education. The Three-Star Approach (TSA) is used by the WinS Program as an integrated system for monitoring, performance recognition and quality assurance guided by DepEd Memorandum No. 194, s. 2018.


Please be advised of the following:

1. Ensure that the downloaded monitoring forms are the latest version which includes the SBFP indicator requesting the number of beneficiaries disaggregated by sex.
2. In the event of a discrepancy between the result of the offline monitoring form and the uploaded monitoring at the e-OMS, the result on the uploaded report in the e-OMS shall be the official star rating. The star rating indicated on the uploaded form shall prevail.
3. For non-DepEd elementary and secondary schools, please upload a blank form only.
4. In the event of an uploading interruption, the issue will be coordinated directly with ICTS-SID. In case the ICTS-SID advises that system maintenance is required, Regional WinS Coordinators will be notified accordingly.

To be guided properly, all ROs and SDOs WinS Coordinators are highly encouraged to revisit DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2016 and DepEd Memorandum No. 194, s. 2018.
