**DIRECTIVES ON THE RATIONALIZATION OF THE FY 2026 BUDGET**

**TO:** Assistant Schools Division Superintendent  
Chief Education Supervisors (CID & SGOD)  
Education Program Supervisors  
Public Schools District Supervisors  
Elementary and Secondary School Heads  
All Others Concerned

Pursuant to the directives emphasized during the National Pre-Management Committee (MANCOM) meeting, this Office mandates the rationalization of the FY 2026 budget utilization across all units, sections, and schools within the Schools Division of Biliran.

I. All funds must be realigned to prioritize the support and successful implementation of DepEd's key programs and projects. To ensure fiscal discipline and compliance with this directive, the following measures are hereby implemented effective immediately:

- 1. Scheduled Meetings:** Face-to-face SDO MANCOM meetings shall be conducted only every two months. Meetings during intervening months shall be held via online platforms.
- 2. Venue Restrictions:** All In-Service Trainings (INSETs) and SDO-led activities are prohibited from being conducted outside the Province.



- 3. Participation Limits:** The number of participants for Regional and National seminars or conventions must be strictly limited to essential personnel only.
  - 4. Austerity in Celebrations:** All lavish Division or School celebrations shall cease. Activities should be simple and cost-effective.
  - 5. Elimination of Non-Essentials:** The provision of freebies and tokens (e.g., leis, T-shirts, souvenirs, and bags) for activities must be minimized or eliminated.
  - 6. Environmental & Fiscal Responsibility:** The use of tarpaulins for events is highly discouraged.
- II. The Chief Education Supervisors and Section Heads are directed to review their respective Project Procurement Management Plans (PPMPs) to reflect these austerity measures and ensure that resources are channeled toward learner-centered initiatives.
- III. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
