3. In the interest of continuous improvement and sports excellence, this activity aims to conduct a comprehensive "root-cause analysis" of the challenges encountered during the training, intensive practice, and actual competition phases.
4. Key areas for review include technical coaching, athlete selection, logistical support, and resource allocation.

5. Identified Tournament Managers, and Lead Coaches are required to submit a Technical Narrative Report incorporating the key areas prior to the meeting. In addition, the Division Sports Coordinator should likewise prepare a PowerPoint presentation which also includes:
  - a. EVRAA Results: Biliran's final medal standings;
  - b. Issues and Concerns: A review of "what went well" and "what went wrong";
  - c. Inventory: Status of Panamao Rangers sports equipment and facilities; and
  - d. Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E): Status of School Sports Clubs.
6. These reports should highlight not only the bottlenecks and gaps but also actionable recommendations to revitalize the Division's sports program for the succeeding athletic season.
7. This Office expresses its sincere gratitude to our local partners for their support and generosity. It is imperative that we now focus on internal recalibration to ensure that the Biliran Panamao Rangers return to a competitive standing in future regional meets.
8. Attendance of all identified personnel is mandatory. Travel and other incidental expenses relative to this activity shall be charged against local/MOOE funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
